



2022 High School Scholarship Awards Program

Announcement

The National Taiwan University Alumni Association of Greater New York (“NTUAA-GNY” hereafter) is pleased to announce that, starting **August 16, 2022**, it will accept and process applications for the 2022 NTUAA-GNY Scholarship Awards Program. All children of NTUAA-GNY members (“NTU-2” hereafter) who will be high school **senior** or **junior** student in fall 2022 are encouraged to apply. While the application deadline is Sunday, **October 2, 2022**, for receiving application form, two recommendation letters, one-page essay, and official high school transcripts for senior(three years) & junior(two years), it is strongly suggested that applicants first submit the application form as early as possible, and then ask two High School teachers/coaches/ advisors to send in the recommendation letters. All required documents must be received by **5 PM, October 2, 2022**. All applicants then will be notified by email about the result by **October 15, 2022**, two weeks before the 2022 Annual Meeting that will be held on **October 29, 2022** at the DoubleTree by Hilton Hotel, 2117 Route 4 Eastbound, Fort Lee, NJ 07024 Phone: (844) 524-8347. Note that **award recipients must be present in person at the Annual Meeting** to receive the Award.

Purpose

The purpose of the NTUAA-GNY High School Scholarship Awards Program is to promote alumni solidarity and to recognize “NTU-2” leadership qualities in academics, extracurricular activities, and community services.

Governance

The Board of Directors of NTUAA-GNY (“Board” hereafter) approves this “Announcement of 2022 High School Scholarship Awards Program,” and may revise it if necessary.

Scholarship Committee (Organized According to Article 8, Section 3 of NTUAA-GNY Bylaws)

1. The Scholarship Committee (“Committee” hereafter) shall consist of three members. The president of NTUAA-GNY shall recommend the Committee Chair for approval by the Board. The Committee Chair shall then recruit members. Any member thereof may be removed by the Committee Chair whenever, in his/her judgment, the best interests of the Association will be served by such removal. Each member shall serve a two-year term. In the event of vacancy by any member before his/her term expires, the replacement member shall serve for the remainder of the unexpired term.
2. In the event that a Director’s children are eligible to apply for the award, the Director shall not serve on the Committee. His/her membership on the Committee shall be replaced by an alternate Director for the year of concern.

Number of Recipients and Amount of Awards

1. The number of recipients and the amount of the individual award will be determined by the Scholarship Committee and, if required, the Board.
2. Starting in 2018, a maximum of three recipients will be selected, and the awards will be \$500 for each.



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3. This scholarship award can only be received one time. If a student receives the award in the junior year, the student will not be allowed to apply the scholarship again in the senior year.

Applicant Qualification

1. Applicants must be children of an NTUAA-GNY member in good standing.
2. Eligible applicants are limited to high school students who are seniors or juniors at the time of the Association's Annual Meeting usually held in the fall.
3. Applicants shall possess the following:
 - a. Academically achieved with a GPA average of 3.5 and above.
 - b. Extraordinary community services.
 - c. Outstanding extracurricular activities.

Application Procedure

1. The announcement and the application form will be posted on NTUAA-GNY website www.ntuaagny.org for applicants to download by **August 16, 2022**.
2. Before the deadline specified in this announcement, all applicants shall submit the following documents, i.e., the application form, two recommendation letters from the applicant's high school teachers/coaches/advisors (letters from non-high school officials are not acceptable), official high school transcripts for senior(three years) & junior(two years), and one-page essay that describes yourself, career goals, and your understanding of the National Taiwan University (<http://www.ntu.edu.tw/>).

Review/Notification/Presentation of Awards

1. The Committee shall meet to select the successful candidates. The Committee may solicit opinions from outside experts as needed for input in specialty areas.
2. The successful candidates will be notified prior to the Association's Annual Meeting. The presentation of the certificate and monetary award to the successful candidates shall be held at the Annual Meeting.
3. Successful candidates must be personally present to receive the award or be disqualified.
